

To enrich the quality of teaching and learning as well as to enhance employ-ability of students, feedback from stakeholders is invaluable. The feedback form consists of items specific to the stakeholders and there are statements which are rated on a 5 point rating scale and one item is qualitative in nature for their open comments. Feedback is taken anonymously from the stakeholders.

We collected online feedback relating to the satisfaction of stakeholders (Student/ Alumni / Faculty/ Employer) towards academic performance and ambience of the institution. After receiving the feedback in the structured format, the IQAC analyzes them and a report is submitted to the higher authority and the management. The information provided is used as important feedback for quality improvement of the teaching and learning process of the institution.

1. Students Feedback

The feedback on academic performance and ambience of the institution from students were obtained after the end of each academic session. Student's opinions were measured on a five-point scale (4 - Strongly agree/3 - Agree/2 - Neutral/1 - Disagree/0 - Strongly disagree). For analysis, all samples of feedback of students from all the Departments were selected. The data collected has been analyzed and the results given below.



The analysis of the results is carried out based on the weighted average of all responses. It indicates that students strongly agree with the fairness of the evaluation process and conduction of examinations. They agree with all other parameters. Most of the students are happy with the academic performance of the institute.

Some major comments from students are Food quality should be improved, Practically knowledge should be give students so that it will be better for future, Overall observation is good, Everything is excellent, The college is over all in good condition, Conduct various Seminars for us, like ,recent trends in the economy, Recent skills required for jobs,Interaction with Industry Specialist etc etc


Action Taken:

Teachers have mainly pointed out that colleges should take initiative to develop ICT enabled classrooms, ICT infrastructure of the Institute.


Action Taken:


Action Taken:
